

# UK Dementia Statistics



There are 850,000 people with dementia in the UK, with numbers set to rise to over one million by 2025. This will soar to two million by 2051.

'Dementia' refers to a set of symptoms caused when the brain is damaged by diseases such as Alzheimer's disease or a series of strokes.

## 1 in 6

people over the age of 80 have dementia



## 70%

of people in care homes have dementia or severe memory problems

## 25K+

of people from ethnic minority backgrounds have dementia

## 40K+

of people under the age of 65 have dementia

## 225K

people will develop dementia this year. That's 1 every 3 minutes!



Symptoms of dementia include memory loss, difficulties with thinking, problem solving and language.
