

**PR31 - Warning to caveator**

**IN THE HIGH COURT OF JUSTICE  
FAMILY DIVISION  
LEEDS DISTRICT PROBATE REGISTRY<sup>(1)</sup>**

To

of<sup>(2)</sup>

a party who has entered a caveat in the estate of<sup>(3)</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ deceased.

You have eight days (starting with the day on which this warning was served on you):

- (i) to enter an appearance either in person or by your [solicitor] [probate practitioner], at the Leeds District Probate Registry, 3rd Floor, Coronet House, Queen Street, Leeds LS1 2BA, setting out what interest you have in the estate of<sup>(3)</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ deceased contrary to that of the party at whose instance this warning is issued; or
- (ii) if you have no contrary interest but wish to show cause against the sealing of a grant to such party, to issue and serve a summons for directions by a District Judge of the Principal Registry or Registrar of a Probate Registry.

If you fail to do either of these, the court may proceed to issue a grant of probate or administration in the said estate notwithstanding your caveat.

**Notes**

1. The nominated Registry for the purpose of caveats, warnings and appearances is Leeds.
2. Name and address, including postcode of caveator.
3. Insert name of the deceased.
4. Here set out the name and address, including postcode of the person warning, his/her interest (under the will (if any)) and the name and address, including postcode of the solicitor, or probate practitioner acting for him/her. If the person warning acts in person this must be stated.
